



Rev. Alan Thames, presbyter of Whitewater Valley Presbytery, Retirement

Announcement – In a letter to the pastors and churches of the Whitewater Valley Presbytery, of which our church is a member, our Executive Presbyter, Rev. Alan Thames, announced his decision to retire at the end of 2023. In reminiscing about his nearly fifteen years as our mid-council leader, Thames shares, "The years have been full. Together as a Presbytery we began some exciting new ministries and concluded other ministries. We explored new opportunities to be Church among an increasingly diverse population. We dismissed congregations to other denominations when they sought different ways to be faithful. In short, we have observed the passing of old ways of church life and have rejoiced over the new things that God has been inviting us to become."

"In recent months, I have heard God's still, small voice speaking through the words of the prophet Isaiah. And this time the invitation is for me to complete my ministry as the Executive Presbyter of Whitewater Valley. I could never begin to express how richly blessed I have been during these years of service among you. The experiences of sitting with individuals and groups discerning God's call. The opportunity to accept and meet challenges as they confronted the Presbytery, the congregations, and individual disciples of Jesus Christ. The joy of observing growth even in the midst of those challenges. The relationships built over time with people for whom I have deep respect and admiration. I am forever shaped by it all."
