





And yet, Christ was born, bringing good news of great joy for all people.

As we move through our series, we hope to create space for acknowledging the weariness of our world while celebrating God's closeness with great joy. And so, this Advent, we will hold space for our weariness and our joy. We will seek a "thrill of hope" in our hurting world. We will welcome joy—even if, like the prophet Isaiah, we cry out for comfort (Isaiah 40:1). In this weary world, may we find many ways to rejoice.
