Dear Friends,
It seems that we have gone from one celebration to another these past few weeks. On Sunday we will recognize our Jubilee members from 1972 through 1974. Everyone is invited to celebrate our Jubilee members during fellowship following worship.

During worship we will also commission our new Stephen Ministers. A Stephen Minister is one who walks beside someone while they are dealing with various issues. We remind them that they are never alone. God is always present when the Stephen Minister "care giver" meets with their "care receiver." God is the "cure giver." Before someone can be commissioned, Stephen

Ministers go through training that emphasizes listening skills, confidentiality, and understanding that the Stephen Minister is NOT to try to fix the issues the care receiver is experiencing. They are to be a sounding board for their care receiver. Stephen Ministers are not psychologists, nor are they Deacons, who might visit their friends once a month. Stephen Ministers may meet with their care receiver once a week, depending on the two peoples' schedules.
