Pastor's Note



Dear First Pres Family,

Six years ago this weekend I moved to Fort Wayne to begin my call with you as your Pastor/Head of Staff. It's hard to believe I'll begin my 7th year of ministry with you on June 1 and celebrate my 28th ordination anniversary. I am not that old! I could wax philosophic about both, but instead I'll

simply say this: I remain as hopeful about the church today as I did back then. I've been blessed to serve two terrific churches in my ministry (you and Faith Des Peres in St. Louis), both of which have long, rich histories (1833 and 1831 respectively) and will continue to long after we're all gone as long as we remain faithful to our calling and follow the Lord's lead. So let us continue to do

just that!

Speaking of . . . the Session has spent a great deal of time over the past year defining who the church is now, who they hope to be in two years, and has set goals to get there. Over the next few weeks, I'll meet with each committee to discuss the goals, and I'll share more about them with you in future letters. I am excited about where we are headed.

But in the meantime, it is summer, which means a bit of a slower pace and some time to reflect and rest. We have a terrific staff here and I hope you'll agree that they deserve some time off. So, if you get a reply email that says they're out of the office, please respect their time away. They've earned it!

In just over a week, we'll welcome nearly 100 campers to our 4th annual MAD2 Camp! Take note later in the e-news where we could use your help. June 9 we'll host all the Fort Wayne churches for worship, and I'll offer a summer sermon series on your 4 favorite hymns. On July 2 we'll welcome our missionary from Syria who will also update us on what our mission partners are doing in Gaza and Israel, and later that month we'll be back at Pridefest. So, while it is slower, we still have things happening. If you're in town, I encourage you to come, listen, learn, and engage your faith.

As we strive to be a church that is seeking the heart of God in the heart of the city, I remain grateful to be in ministry with all of you. And as we celebrate Memorial Day, let us remember that it's not about BBQs and mattress sales, it's about remembering our military who have died in service to this great country.
