FPC Study Connection Tutors: Is It Worthwhile? Recently I received a note from a former student who had been in my class several decades ago, and I brightened up with the expectation of his belated appreciation for Latin. But no. He recounted a day when I stopped him in the hall after he had served detention for smoking, and I had apparently shared a very personal and tragic story about the perils of



tobacco. He wrote that he had overcome the habit then and was still grateful to me. I had no memory of the brief encounter.

I share this only as an anecdotal example of the power of simply connecting with a young person, even for an hour a week. I have witnessed the lit-up faces, the hugs, the shy smiles of our students upon entering our Study Connection room. This may be the only time in the week when an adult is waiting to greet them with a warm welcome, a snack, a book to read, and a game to play. Are there frustrations? Yes. Do they all make visible progress? No. Is it worthwhile? As worthwhile as any endeavor forged from love and hope for the betterment of our community's children.

Schools Team: The Mission Committee of First Presbyterian Church is once again partnering with Blessings in a Backpack to provide weekend food for the children at Washington Elementary School. By way of information, 70% of the children in Fort Wayne Community Schools struggle with food insecurity. Blessings in a Backpack, a



nonprofit organization, combats this by providing children in our schools with a nutritious bag of food in their backpacks every Friday during the school year, ensuring that children not endure an entire weekend before being fed again.

First Pres participated in this program until the pandemic forced Blessings to commercially pack and deliver the bags.

It was a very popular activity with our congregation! Every Sunday during the coffee hour long tables were set up at one end of McKay Hall, and an assembly line of volunteers filled the bags! It only took about 15 minutes to fill 200+ bags!

We need 4 or 5 volunteers to commit to one Sunday a month throughout the school year to set up the food to be assembled, supervise the filling of the bags, and cleaning up at the end. It would take probably one hour of volunteering for whatever Sunday you chose to be a team leader. We are also in need of 2 or 3 people to load the church van with the bags and deliver to Washington School on Fridays.
