Pastor's Note



Dear First Pres Friends,

My sermon series "Who Is My Neighbor" continues this week with a look at 1 Corinthians 12 and Paul's discussion of gifts. His use of the human body as a way to talk about the different gifts we have is one of the more well-known passages in the Bible, and I'm eager to explore it with you.

Opening this weekend in the theater is "Beauty and the Beast". We all know the basic story of Beauty and the Beast: To learn to love and be loved . . . A young prince under a curse that only his true love can remove . . . and they must fall in love even though the prince looks like a frightening Beast.

But remember, too, that this is a story of a town, a seemingly idyllic community where neighbors know, care and work with each other until a handsome bully dupe them into believing that a beast is out to get them and ruin their town. This turns neighbor against neighbor until the truth is revealed and the bully is removed and all are brought back together supporting each other once again. Join us for this timeless tale about welcoming old and new friends, what it means to be a neighbor, and how a community comes together in this provincial town. Tickets can be purchased at the door or online/phone through Artstix, though they are almost sold out for opening night and Sunday's matinee.


