Attention FPC Members:

Email invitations to join our church directory in *Realm* are now being sent! If your email address has changed in the last 2 years, please email <u>Cheri Umphrey</u> or call the church office so you do not miss your invitation!

When you receive your email invitation from *Realm*, you simply click on the link that is contained in the invite and from there, you would:

- 1. Get registered on Realm.
- 2. Once you are logged in, in the upper right corner you'll see your initials and name. Click on "My Account" after you click on your name at the top right. Go to "Privacy".
- 3. From there, you can give permission as to who can see what of your profile or select "custom privacy". NOTE: If you don't allow "anyone in the church", people will not be able to access your address, phone or email. They will only see your name in the Directory.
- 4. Please know that the only information members can see is your contact information, personal information (which appears as birthday with year), and groups you're a member of (such as: choir, session, etc.)
- 5. If you have contact information to correct or want to upload a picture, you can do that.
