## Pastor's Letter



Dear First Pres Friends,

It's Palm Sunday this week. We'll begin outside in the Courtyard for the 11:00 service, where we'll read the story of Jesus entering Jerusalem and hear the crowd's hopeful response. With waving palms and singing, we'll re-create that leafy parade into the city from so long ago as we process into the sanctuary.

But as we continue through the story, the mood begins to shift. The shadow of the cross looms larger, and we remember that the same voices crying "Hosanna" will soon cry "Crucify him." Palm Sunday marks the turning point in our journey, and invites us to walk—together—through the depth and drama of Holy Week.

So let us mark these most sacred days of our faith with intention and care. Please take a moment to review the schedule for our Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter services below.

And then—after the shadows—we will gather again in joy to proclaim the astonishing news of Easter morning: that love is stronger than death, and that Christ is risen, indeed.

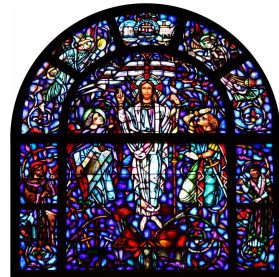
