PROTECT YOUR HEALTH

CDC-recommended vaccines for children and adults will be available.

One MMR dose is recommended for adults who received a less-effective measles vaccine between 1963 and 1967.

Available Vaccines

Measles (MMR)	1st Dose: 12 months 2nd Dose: 4-6 years
Routine Childhood Vaccines	Children should receive vaccinations at specific ages to best protect them from serious preventable diseases.
Tdap Tetanus Diphtheria Pertussis	Adults: Boosters are recommended every 10 years and during each pregnancy
