Dear First Pres Friends,

This Sunday we'll ordain and install new Elders and Deacons. I hope you'll be here to support them with your prayers as they begin their service. It's a special and meaningful day in the life of the church.

Our Music and Drama Search Teams have been working diligently since hosting the listening forums. They've taken to heart what you shared—your hopes and dreams, your concerns and convictions—and are now using that feedback to draft position descriptions for our next Director of Music Ministries/Organist and Director of Dramatic Arts Ministry. We hope to post the Music position by the end of the month, and the Drama position soon after.
