

New Sermon Series

Pastor Annie Epling begins Practicing Our Faith on Sunday, October 12: Life brings both extraordinary challenges and everyday stresses—and in a world marked by uncertainty, conflict, and constant noise, it can be hard to stay grounded. How do we live with hope and faith in the midst of it all?

This three-part sermon series, inspired by Practicing Our Faith by Dorothy Bass, explores spiritual practices that root us in God's love and help us live with intention, courage, and grace.
