This simple phrase brought smiles to everyone at our recent staff meeting. While we were discussing our upcoming Thanksgiving Dinner, one staff member described the menu for the day in this wonderfully concise way. We laughed because it was a clear and accurate definition — but I especially loved it because it beautifully captures the

identity of our church.

Our Thanksgiving Dinner began in 1985, when our church invited 13 Korean War veterans. Ever since, this gathering has been a time to comfort and honor many who still carry the deep wounds of that war. At the same time, it has become a precious event where the Korean group and the American group of First Presbyterian Church share gratitude, love, and fellowship with one another.

This year as well, on Sunday, November 23, after worship, kimchi and

turkey will meet again in McKay Hall. Everyone is invited — please come! As we look back on the year, I pray it will be a time for us to give thanks, to affirm our love for one another, and to move forward together toward the mission God has given us.


### Interfaith Food Drive Success


