직분 소개 Introduction of the Office

Leader: The office of 'Kwonsa' is a unique and meaningful tradition within the Korean church, established to empower and honor female leadership, although it does not formally exist in the PCUSA system. A Kwonsa is called to build up the church's virtues, help the needy, and offer encouragement and comfort to those with weak faith. Today, we officially recognize and install these two female leaders to serve the body of Christ.
