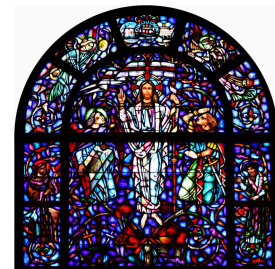

Also, **DO NOT** click links in random text messages or emails. If the message appears to be from someone you trust, call them directly immediately.

Legitimate organizations will rarely ask you to confirm passwords or sensitive data out of the blue! If you ever have doubts about the legitimacy of a request for donations or any other communication from the church, please do not hesitate to contact our church office directly at 260-426-7421.
